120+ delegates from Sweden and Europe met in Norrkoping, Sweden to explore the extent of music's role within places and to share ideas for integrating music into future plans, structures and ecosystems in cities.

The event started on September 26th with a VIP city tour and opening reception at the Museum of Work, where attendees got to know the history of the city as well as enjoy some drinks and live music by the local artist Hardy H Hum.

The day after, 120+ Swedish and international delegates met at Horsalen to explore the relationship between music, economic development and city planning through panels, presentations, roundtables and insights from Europe's top music city experts. The event also featured live music from local artists and an evening reception with drinks and snacks.

On September 28th, delegates had the chance to experience the famous Norrkoping Culture Night and attend a special concert by the Norrköping Symphony Orchestra.


