MUSIC TOURISM CONVENTION POSTPONED TO 2021 DUE TO COVID-19

The 5th global convening on music and tourism will now take place on Sept 29 - Oct 2 2021

(CLEVELAND, MS) - Tourism organizations, the music & events industry and academics from around the world would have gathered in Cleveland, Mississippi this September for the fifth global edition of the Music Tourism Convention. The unprecedented global pandemic has led to event hosts Visit Mississippi, the city of Cleveland Mississippi & Music Cities Events taking the decision to postpone the event to Sept 29 - Oct 2 2021.

Luke Jones, the CEO of Music Cities Events explains the reasoning behind the postponement, "We've looked at all of the factors created by Covid-19 which are impacting this year's event, and have decided alongside our partners that we need to postpone to ensure that we can organise the best event possible. We are extremely sorry for the inconvenience caused, but we're working closely with our event partners to guarantee that 2021 will be an even bigger and more international event than originally planned. We can't wait to bring 300+ global delegates to Cleveland, Mississippi and the Mississippi Delta in Fall 2021."

Ticket holders will be contacted with more information, with all purchased tickets being valid for the new event dates. If ticket holders can't make the new dates then they will have the option to transfer the value of the ticket bought towards a subscription of Music Cities Events' brand new online platform, the Music Cities Community, or request a full refund.

"Ensuring the safety of locals and visitors is the top priority for the state," said Visit Mississippi Director Craig Ray. "While we can't wait to welcome leading music and tourism professionals from around the world to the Birthplace of America's Music, we will use the next year to make sure this event is the best of its kind."

Music Tourism Convention is hosted by Visit Mississippi, the City of Cleveland Mississippi, Sound Diplomacy, and Music Cities Events and will now take place in Cleveland, Mississippi on 29 Sept - 2 Oct 2021.
